Did you know?

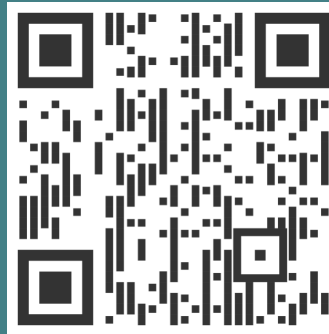
- The final report of the Gilberton local area traffic management and parking plan identified 24 high priority initiatives.
- The speed of traffic along Gilbert Street and rat-running through Tyne Street are major issues.
- Simpson and Gilbert Street form part of the 'Levels Bikeway' route.
- None of the traffic calming measures have been implemented.
- The introduction of the parking restrictions was not actually a priority for the Gilberton suburb.
